This schedule is preliminary and subject to change.

The 2025 eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series schedule returns to many of the mainstays of the last 15 seasons, as well as a couple of new additions to the fold.

Daytona kicks off the season, both officially and unofficially as the eNASCAR Clash returns to the 2.5-mile Superspeedway in Daytona Beach, Florida. The season will once again end at Homestead-Miami Speedway, as it did the last two season and multiple seasons prior.

In between, there are two new additions to the schedule, along with a couple of returning venues from seasons past.

Slotted in the third race of the season is the series' inaugural visit to the Autódromo José Carlos Pace, also known as Interlagos, located in Brazil. The other new track on the schedule is technically a returning venue as well, as it was last seen in 2019 during an eNASCAR All-Star event live on NBCSN—Rockingham Speedway will make its points-paying race debut on April 8th.

The season is once again split into Segments, with three of them residing in the 2025 Regular Season. The first five races make up the first Segment, the next four make up Segment 2, and the final five in the Regular Season will make up the third and final Segment. Consider them their own mini championships, with the drivers who score the most points in those time frames collecting an extra five Playoff Points as well as \$3,000 in cash.

This year will also see the return of the Short Track and Road Course formats. At Richmond and Iowa, the events will include Heat racing to set the lineups, and will award points in each Heat result. At Interlagos and Chicago, those races will have an invert after qualifying, since points will be paid to the top-8 qualifiers, plus a Sprint Race to set the grid for the Feature race.

10 drivers will qualify for the eNASCAR Playoffs, but only four can fight for the championship at Homestead-Miami.

BACK AT IT AGAIN IN 2025

Last season's eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series championship concluded in dramatic fashion, with Parker White outdueling Steven Wilson, Bobby Zalenski, and Graham Bowlin to claim his first career title.

Now, White will look to defend his title against those same three rivals, as well as 36 other hopeful competitors competing for the Dale Earnhardt Jr Cup this year.

WILL WE EVER GET ANOTHER REPEAT CHAMP?

Only Ray Alfalla can claim multi-time series champion status, as 4-time is the only one to-date still as the series enters its 16th season in 2025. Wilson came close to the back-to-back, but White would not be denied in our most recent championship showdown.

Still without a title in 2025 includes Bobby Zalenski, a man of many titles, including Mr. Championship 4. Could this be his



season, finally? What about Tucker Minter, who nearly won it all in his rookie campaign two seasons ago? Don't forget about Graham Bowlin or Garrett Lowe, two drivers that have made it to Uptown Charlotte in the past few years with a chance at hoisting the cup.

Even with all of those potential new champions, this could be the year we finally see another repeat. Wilson will be as poised as ever, while White won't want to let go of it. Casey Kirwan, Nick Ottinger, and Zack Novak have all been in the conversation as well in the last few seasons, so if there's any year to do it, this could be the one!

THE FIELD HAS NEVER BEEN CLOSER

Last season, 13 drivers visited virtual victory lane. That is nearly a third of the entire roster! While Steven Wilson still collected the majority with four wins, only Bobby Zalenski and the eventual champion, Parker White, had more than one.

White was among the five drivers who scored their first-career wins in the 2024 season. Daniel Faulkingham broke through and made it to the eNASCAR Playoffs as well with his Indy win. Wyatt Tinsley, Malik Ray, and Briar LaPradd also scored their first wins in the series.

We said goodbye to the 2021 series champion this offseason, as Keegan Leahy hung up the sim wheel for the time being. Still, he made sure to collect one more win to add to his total before calling it quits, winning at Las Vegas. We also saw Dylan Duval snap one of the longest streaks in history, winning for the first time since 2016 to compete for his first championship in 2024.





2025 SILLY SEASON RECAP

For the first time since the inception of the Team Championship in 2019, more than 40 drivers entered the 2025 eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series Free Agency period with hopes of signing on to compete in the upcoming season.

When the dust settled, 40 of the 49 drivers were locked in for the year. A whopping eight rookies were selected among the available teams. Former champions of the series made moves to new places, but there were still many faces in the same places as the season prior.

CONTINUING TO BUILD ONTO THE FOUNDATION

Of the 40 drivers signed for 2025, about 18 of those drivers stayed put in one way or another with the team, or a new incarnation of the team that they drove with in 2024. Nick Ottinger might be the longest-tenured driver again this year, sticking with William Byron eSports for the sixth-straight season.

NEW SCENES

With the rotation of teams in and out, some drivers found new homes for the 2025 season. Steven Wilson was part of the carousel of drivers in new places this year, signing along with Femi Olatunbosun at Spire Motorsports. Casey Kirwan left Spire to race with Kansas City in 2025.

NEW TEAMS ADDED IN 2025

A handful of new teams are included on the 2025 roster, including the Vegas Inferno, Six Karma, ERA eSports, and Apex Racing Team. Hyak Motorsports, formerly JTG Daugherty, returns this year. Also, a force from 2023 returns with Jim Beaver eSports back in the fold.

A SUPER ROOKIE CLASS

EIGHT drivers will contest the eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series in 2025 for the first time. Eddie Kerner, the 2024 Contender champion, will go against the likes of former broadcast booth member, Blake McCandless, as well as other hopefuls looking to break in and stay in the series.

One of iRacing's most versatile drivers, Logan Clampitt's adaptability helped him win the 2019 Mazda Hot Lap Challenge, which allowed him to test a Global MX-5 Cup car with Mazda Motorsports, and has seen him in two other World Championships in the past. Still a top threat on the sim, Logan battled back up the eNASCAR Road to Pro ladder in 2024, securing a spot in Free Agency for 2025. 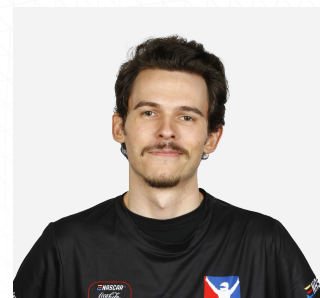

AUTOBIOGRAPHY

I am Michael Cosey Jr, 26 years old from Hagerstown, Maryland. I fell in love with NASCAR at an early age, but without the means to get into any real life racing, I quickly found racing video games, such as the PlayStation 2 NASCAR games, NASCAR Racing 2003 Season, and iRacing in early 2012.

I started my YouTube channel around the same time, and have been lucky enough to grow that to over 33k subscribers along side my sim racing journeys. In Sim Racing, my two proudest achievements are being the all-time winningest driver in (RODDCAR), the longest active running Superspeedway League on iRacing, and the win I'm most known for, the eRacr Firecracker 400, pushed on the white flag lap by my childhood favorite driver, Dale Earnhardt Jr, to pull off my biggest win in Sim Racing to date. The feeling of winning that race is what constantly drives me to pushing harder each race towards winning at the eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series level.

In two seasons of eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series competition, I believe my rookie season reflects most accurately the level of drive I am. Consistency all year with seven top 10's and just missing out on pointing into the playoffs after getting wrecked in two of the last three races. Unfortunately, for my Sophomore season, it seemed the more speed I brought, the worse luck I had getting caught up in wrecks, or calling the wrong strategies. While it felt like a disaster of a season, I still managed 16th in points thanks to the bonus points scored in Heat races like Richmond this year, where I scored my first career Pole position and Heat win.

I'm hoping to land with any team that has experience with iRacing, is passionate for racing, eNASCAR competition, and growing the series on all levels. I am excited to fight for race wins in 2025 and continue to be one of the leaders in social media for the series.

One of the most prolific oval iRacers and iRacing streamers in the world, Casey Kirwan is one of the few with over 10,000 iRating and more than 1000 victories in his iRacing career, including five at the top level, in the eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series.

He punched his ticket into the 2022 eNASCAR playoffs where he earned the right to race for a title at the NASCAR Hall of Fame—and after a thrilling duel with Bobby Zalenski, he earned his first series championship.

2023 was arguably his most competitive to date, winning twice for the first time, but he came up short in his quest to defend the title, ultimately finishing seventh. Casey has also been dabbling in the world of road racing, where he won the PESG All-Stars title in 2023 and was a part of a winning GTP entry in the IMSA Esports finale at Daytona.

Casey streams regularly on Twitch, racing whatever the iRacing service has to offer, alongside competing in the eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series and IMSA Esports Global Championship during their respective season.

The 2024 **eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series** ran from February to October in 2024. The Top 20 drivers in the final standings were invited to return back to the series in 2025 while the Bottom 20 drivers were relegated down to the 2024 **eNASCAR Contender iRacing Series**.

To go up against the **Coca-Cola Series'** relegated drivers, potential drivers were tasked with taking on the **Road to Pro** ladder, which consists of official iRacing series split racing utilizing NASCAR Trucks and NASCAR Xfinity Cars.

The **Road to Pro** ladder system consists of three rounds:

- eNASCAR Qualifying iRacing Series, Round 1
- eNASCAR Qualifying iRacing Series, Round 2
- eNASCAR Contender iRacing Series

iRacing members that were not in the 2024 **eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series** all started in the **eNASCAR Qualifying iRacing Series, Round 1**, from February to June. 70 drivers from there then advanced to the **eNASCAR Qualifying iRacing Series, Round 2**, which ran from July to September.

The Top 23 drivers from **Qualifying** would be invited to compete in **Contender** this season after three relegated drivers opted not to return. This season's **Contender**, which ran from October to November, consisted of 17 relegated **Coca-Cola Series** drivers versus 23 **Qualifying** drivers, some rookies and some series veterans among the mix.

30 drivers from that mix have ultimately qualified or re-qualified for the 2025 **eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series** roster through **Contender** to make a total of 49 drivers in the 2025 Free Agency Pool. One driver who finished inside the Top 20 in the **Coca-Cola Series** in 2024 opted not to return.
