The 2026 eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series schedule is the biggest its ever been, at 24 races from February to October. 11 of those races existed in the Qualifying Series section of the schedule. The Championship Series is the top level races, and there will be 13 of those this season.

While the Qualifying Series kicked things off at Daytona, the Championship Series will start their season off for the first time at Charlotte Motor Speedway, with the Coca-Cola 160, the longest race of the season. Many tracks return from 2025 to the Championship Series schedule, including Dover, Iowa, Indianapolis, Nashville, Richmond, Daytona, Michigan, Texas, Kansas, and Homestead-Miami. EchoPark makes its return to the fold for the first time since 2024. Qualcomm Circuit at Naval Base Coronado is the only new circuit on this season's schedule.

The season is once again split into Segments, with three of them residing in the 2026 Regular Season. The first three races make up the first Segment, the next three make up Segment 2, and the final three in the Regular Season will make up the third and final Segment. Consider them their own mini championships, with the drivers who score the most points in those time frames collecting an extra five Playoff Points as well as \$3,000 in cash.

Once those nine races are complete, the season shifts to Playoff mode. Another three-race mini season will occur, but this time, just the 10 Playoff drivers will fight for their spot in the 2026 Championship 4 Finale, the 13th and final race of the Championship Series season.

This year will also see the return of the Short Track and Road Course formats. At Iowa and Richmond, the events will include Heat racing to set the lineups, and will award points in each Heat result. There's only one road race on the schedule this season, at Coronado, and that race will have an invert after qualifying, since points will be paid to the top-8 qualifiers, plus a Sprint Race to set the grid for the Feature race.

The Playoffs look similar to previous seasons with the return of Michigan and Texas, but the penultimate race will now be at Kansas instead of Phoenix. On October 13th, the Championship will once again be decided on stage at the NASCAR Hall of Fame in Uptown Charlotte, North Carolina, with racing at Homestead-Miami Speedway, the champion ultimately hoisting the trophy and \$100,000 check by night's end.

## DIFFERENT LOOK FOR 2026

The eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series has a whole new look for 2026. While Charlotte Motor Speedway kicks off the Championship Series portion of the schedule, there have already been 11 Qualifying Series events from February to April that helped set the Free Agency Roster. As a result, the Championship Series only has 13 races in it, nine of which reside in the Regular Season, so prospective champions will need to be on it from the drop of the first green flag to have a shot at season's end.

### STEVEN WILSON'S WORLD, AND WE'RE JUST LIVING IN IT

Before the conclusion of the 2025 season, only one driver—Ray Alfalla—had more than a single championship to their name.

Enter Steven Wilson.

If not for a wild finish in 2024, we might be talking about a



driver with three titles to his name already. Regardless, Wilson grabbed his second title in dominant fashion at the NASCAR Hall of Fame last year, and set a new record with his eighth win on the season, the most wins in a single season in eNASCAR history. The hottest shoe in the series, will Wilson continue his dominance into the 2026 campaign?



### CHAMPIONSHIP 4 FORMAT STILL LIVES IN ENASCAR

One thing that will set the virtual series apart from its real-world counterpart is that the eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Championship Series will once again feature the Championship 4 and Playoff format in 2026. That means there will be a field of 10 drivers fighting for the title, with four drivers advancing from that three-race round to compete on stage at the NASCAR Hall of Fame once more to hoist the Dale Earnhardt Jr Cup. This format was also previously used in the top levels of NASCAR's National Series, but this year, those real-world contests will utilize a variant of the Chase for the Cup. Win and you're in is still in play over here, but with less races, points will be more important than ever!

### TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP COULD BE THE CLOSEST YET

Less races on a calendar means the 2026 Team Championship has to potential to be closer than ever before. Last season, Spire Motorsports, Channel 199 Sim Racing, ERA eSports Team, Williams F1 Team Gaming, William Byron eSports, and the Kansas City Pioneers were among the teams locked into a season-long ebb and flow of points. Spire wound up taking the title after a late season surge from Wilson's teammate, Femi Olatunbosun, allowed the organization to get a gap over Channel 199 by season's end.



## 2026 SILLY SEASON RECAP

The biggest eNASCAR Free Agency pool was in play during this year's signing period. 52 drivers entered by means of three different avenues—either finishing inside the Top 20 during the 2025 Championship Series season, finishing in the Top 30 during the 2026 Qualifying Series season, or being one of the two eNASCAR College iRacing Series challengers from one of the previous seasons. Only 40 drivers could sign, however, with the 20 official teams. There were both expected and unexpected moments. Some drivers like Wyatt Tinsley and Blake Reynolds are back after a season or multiple seasons not running at the top.

### KEEPING THE STATUS QUO

Seven teams stayed exactly the same from 2025 to 2026, including three of the top teams—ERA, Williams, and the champions at Spire. Another eight teams retained one of their two drivers to build on that program, including Channel 199 keeping Dylan Duval, WBe keeping Tucker Minter, the Pioneers keeping Casey Kirwan, and Kanaan keeping Vicente Salas.

### CH-CH-CH-CHANGES!

Only three of the returning teams are showing up with completely new rotations in 2026. RFK and eRacr both grabbed a pair of rookie racers, but JR Motorsports made big waves by signing Zack Novak and Malik Ray away from their former teams over to their rebuilding program.

### RICK WARE AND THIBAUT COURTOIS SQUAD UP

This year saw the most teams return from 2025, which meant there was only room for two new teams. Motorsport organization Rick Ware Racing, which competes in the NASCAR Cup Series, and the esports organization of a Belgian professional footballer named Thibaut Courtois are the two new teams this season.

### EVEN MORE ROOKIES IN CLASS OF 2026

Nine drivers will contest the eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series in 2026 for the first time. Sebastian Marin shone in the Qualifying Series, as did Matthew Morton. Dylan Basen was a strong competitor in second split, and Qual Series winners Seth Noell, Logan Helton, and Kenny Brady are locked in too!

Tommy Gossett's story is one of faith, perseverance, and determination. Originally from Tennessee and now living in Panama City Beach, Florida, Tommy has turned his passion and determination into incredible results on iRacing, and an eye towards digital media.. From a young age, Tommy has faced challenges that most people will never fully understand. Tommy was diagnosed with Sever's disease, which has caused lifelong fractures in his heels, degenerated ankles and knees, a curved spine, hips out of line, and weak bones throughout the lower half of his body. Tommy lives with five fractures in his right heel and four in his left. Tommy has to wear special orthotics in his shoes to get through everyday life. Because of how brittle his bones are, Tommy was no longer able to pursue real-world racing. The risk is simply too great. One bad hit could leave him paralyzed. For Tommy, eNASCAR is not just a hobby or a competition platform, it is his one opportunity to truly live out his dream of being a NASCAR driver. Growing up with his condition meant he was never able to play sports or enjoy much of the recreation that many take for granted. But through that, Tommy developed something even deeper: a strong love for his family, a grounded perspective on life, and an unshakable faith in God. At the center of Tommy's life is his faith. Even through the struggles, Tommy says that he has been blessed beyond belief. After a routine blood draw in May of 2025 went awry, Tommy was diagnosed with a severe form of vasovagal syncope. This led to fainting episodes, up to 25 times a day, erratic heart rate, and blood pressure irregularities. Through the end of 2025, his health only deteriorated. In January of 2026, Tommy had to make the difficult decision together with his doctors and family that he had to leave his hometown of Smyrna, Tennessee and move to a climate that would help his body recover, that being Panama City Beach, Florida. Nevertheless, Tommy fought and battled through all the obstacles to still get to this point, become eligible for the series, and ultimately land a ride for the 2026 Championship season.

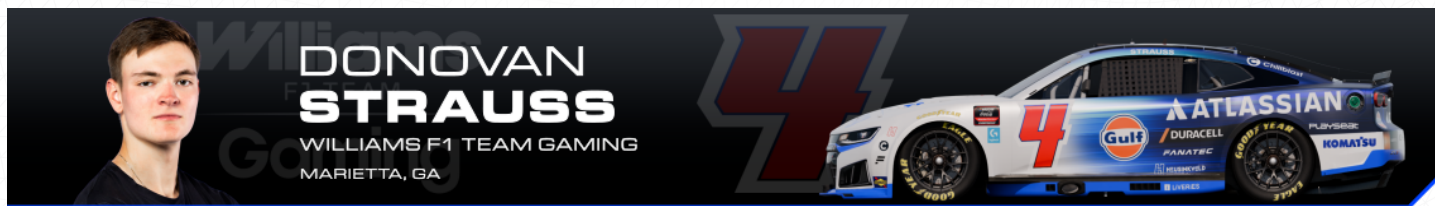

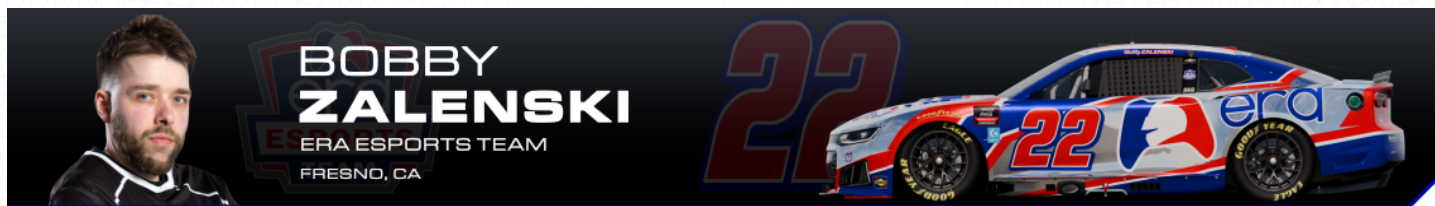

Bobby has channeled that passion towards sim racing, and it's been quite fruitful. Bobby lives with severe scoliosis that he has had surgeries for, so he says that he's got a bit of a unique look. Bobby is one of the greats of the series, up high on the most wins leaderboard, and is often considered the "Road Course King" of the series. Bobby has made it to the Championship 4 more than any other driver, but is still seeking that first career title.

## 2026 ROSTER NOTES

The 2025 **eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Series** ran from February to October in 2025. The Top 20 drivers in the final standings were invited to return back to the series in 2026 while the Bottom 20 drivers were relegated out of the series.

Those relegated out were tasked with taking on the new 2026 **eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Qualifying Series** from February to April in 2025. The Top 30 drivers after 11 races became eligible for Free Agency. Over 1,900 drivers attempted the Qualifying Series. Races were split into groups of 33 to 37 drivers each, and points were distributed among the different splits by virtue of the Strength of Field. On average, winning a Split 2 race was the equivalent of a Top 5 finish in Split 1.

Two more drivers were included in this year's Free Agency, those spots earned through the 2024-25 **eNASCAR College iRacing Series**. As it was written, the Top 2 drivers in the final College Series standings not already entered in that season's eNASCAR Coca-Cola iRacing Championship Series were extended an invite.
